INSTRUCTIONS for PHOTOS

All submissions need to be accompanied by digital photos. These can be taken with a iphone or digital camera Photos should not be blurry or dark. Choose an uncluttered background that the horse will stand out against. The sun should be behind your back when you take the photo. The horse should be standing as square as possible on level ground. The photographer should stand with the eye of the camera postioned at the horse's girth line (just slightly behind the shoulders) with the horse's entire body absolutely parallel to the camera to avoid distorted angles. The camera's eye should not be looking down (or up) on the subject, but approximately level or slightly below the line of the back.

Four main photos are Required - Left Side, Right Side, Front, Rear.
